Killarney School is excited to announce that the Killarney Foundation is supporting our school with grants of \$16,000 and \$20,000!!

The Foundation recognizes our North Gym as a multi-purpose learning space that allows students to socially distance themselves and access technology so that they can successfully participate in learning while observing our COVID related regulations. With the \$16,000 grant, we are able to purchase a large venue projector, a wall mounted projector screen, 16 Chromebooks and a Chromebook cart. In the event that we move to Level Orange or Red and are required to have 2 meters of physical distancing, the north gym could ultimately be used as a space to bring larger groups together. The screen and projector will continue to be a great addition to the gym and will be used for presentations, meetings, assemblies, gym class, etc...

Earlier this year, The Killarney Foundation also supported our school with a grant of nearly \$20,000 to upgrade our sound system with wireless headset microphones, a sound board and amp. These additions will improve the sound quality at Christmas concerts, band concerts and drama productions!


I will be setting up Remembrance Day and winter displays for November. Also watch for many new books coming out soon! Hope you all are having a safe and healthy fall!
