However, in order to meet with you privately, they will take you back to their classrooms in order to have deeper discussions about your child's progress.

Once again, the gym will serve as a show case for the learning that has taken place: student art, woodworking, course projects and videos. In order to prepare, your child will be given the opportunity in each course to consider what they would like to share. Everyone will continue to select one piece that can be written, pictured, photocopied or electronic. They will be taught how to present it to you from their learning perspective. For example, what was the most difficult part they had to work through? What was the least difficult? Where did they grow or become stronger or more knowledgeable? They will have time at school in their advisor groups to practice what this should look like and to polish their presentations. You will also be able to choose from a

list of discussion questions and ideas to assist in the conversation.
